COVID-19 UPDATE

We are happy we can meet you personally during our conference. Please note: we apply and secure the actual COVID-19 measurements of the Dutch National Government at all times. That means that at this moment, there will be a **corona check** at the door. You need to make use of the Corona Check app. You can download the Corona Check app in the App store or Google Play store. This app generates a QR code of a negative PCR test based on a sample collected no more than 24 hours before the event, proof of recovery, or proof of vaccination. **This QR code will be checked before you get access. This is very important, without this QR code you can't get access.**

If you are from outside of the Netherlands, you can also use your international QR code.

A certificate on paper is convenient if you don't have a smartphone, you can make a QR code on paper on the following website: <https://coronacheck.nl/en/print/>
Please make sure you bring this printed paper with you to the conference venue.

In case you need to get tested to get access to the conference, please note there is a COVID-19 test location for PCR tests next to the venue. You have to book an appointment in advance via <https://afspraak.testenvoortoeegang.org/> This negative PCR test result is valid for 24 hours.

Please select test location: *Locht 117, 5504 RM, Eindhoven (Spoedtest.nl)*

We ask you to:

- Wash your hands often
- Cough and sneeze into your elbow
- Avoid handshaking
- Stay at home if you have symptoms

KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

Since there are fixed seats, it is not mandatory to keep 1.5 metres distance from each other. We do however, encourage to keep your distance as much as possible.

USE OF FACE MASKS

The Dutch National Government has decided that face masks are mandatory in spaces where there are no fixed seats. As such, we ask you to bring a face mask and wear it in the halls of the conference venue. When seated in the lecture rooms, you can take the mask off.
